Prior to coming to Defiance, in six seasons as the assistant at Hanover College (IN), Cutter helped guide the Panthers to an overall record of 101-58 and an HCAC mark of 75-33. which was the most wins in the conference over that time period. Prior to that, he spent one season at Ohio Wesleyan University, where the team went 17-9, and a second place finish in the North Coast Athletic Conference. During that year, he also founded the Greater Columbus Basketball Camp. Cutter began his coaching career as an assistant here at Defiance College from 2003-2007. During that period of time, he assisted in the program going from last place to a HCAC Championship over a 2 year period. Over his career, he has gained experience as a camp instructor at a number of basketball camps including Xavier, Gonzaga, Stanford, Miami University (OH), and the University of Cincinnati.
